Plumbers install and maintain water systems in homes and businesses – sinks, toilets, showers, boilers, and radiators. You'll cut, bend, and join pipes, follow technical diagrams, and use tools to install or fix heating systems.

## Apprenticeships

Apprenticeships are a great way to earn while you learn. You'll spend most of your time working with an employer, gaining hands-on experience, and study part-time at a local college to achieve a nationally recognised qualification.

Apprenticeships usually start at Level 2 and progress to Level 3. Entry requirements vary, but many providers will support you to achieve English and Maths qualifications if needed.
